<b>GENERAL RULES :</b>			
<b>Solvency certificate</b> shall be in the prescribed proforma given and should be on the bank's letter head and from his bankers addressed to the concerned enlisting authority (OR) The solvency should be in the name of the applicant or any of the partner and should be obtained from the Revenue Department official not below the rank of Tehasildar and issued not earlier than six months from the date of application.			
Previous experience: Should have satisfactorily executed the works in Government departments & reputed private sectors during the last 7 years as on 31.03.2013 with completion certificates and TDS certificates.			
Registration being continuous process vendors can register themselves with current status of completion along with TDS certificates and also for up gradation.			
The validity of registration is for <b>THREE</b> years subject to the conditions specified at <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Response level,</li> <li>2. Disqualify</li> <li>3. Confirmation of the status once in 4 years.</li> </ol>			
Those who have enlisted with us will also to apply fresh to include suitably in the list of registered contractors for one or more work.			
All the contractors are required to apply to the Income Tax officers of the area in which they are assessed for grant of Income Tax Clearance Certificate in the month of May every year. The tax clearance certificate in original should be submitted to the department who has enlisted the contractor by the end of June every year.			
The contractors, who fails to submit the Tax Clearance Certificate or fails to show any justifiable reasons for non-supply of the Income Tax Clearance Certificate in their names, will be liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors.			
Contractors will be required to certify that they will not get themselves registered under more than one name.			
Contractors who are near relatives responsible for award and execution of contract where their near relative is working will not be allowed to tender for works. A near relative will include wife, husband, parents and grandparents, children and grandchildren, brothers and sisters, uncles, aunt and cousin and their corresponding in-laws.			
The list of approved contractors will be reviewed periodically with a view to recommending the weeding out of contractors guilty of malpractice or otherwise unsuitable.			
Contractors are required to respond to all enquiries sent to them. In case of non-response for 3 consecutive tenders his/their registration status will be cancelled.			
PF registration is not mandatory for registering the contractor, however they have to produce the PF registration number once they became successful bidder and they have to submit the ESI Account with the code numbers allotted to the contractor by appropriate authorities at the time of application. They all comply with the all statutory requirements including minimum wages declared by NBPPL. On award of contract, they shall obtain necessary license under contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act and Comply with the provision of the said Act.
